

STUDENTS CAN BE EXPECTED TO:

- Make the most of educational opportunities through active classroom participation and involvement in other school activities, both in and out of class.
- Respect the teaching and learning of others.
- Ride to and from school on the school bus according to division rules.
- Attend school regularly and punctually.
- Complete work missed due to absence.
- Develop self-discipline and be responsible for their actions.
- Show courtesy and respect for ALL people and property in the school and community.
- Take pride in their work and what they have accomplished.
- Demonstrate behavior that contributes to an orderly, caring and safe learning environment.
- Respect and demonstrate consideration for other cultures and other peoples' differences.

STUDENTS EXPECT THAT:

- They will be able to work in a school atmosphere which is safe, secure, non threatening and conducive of their learning.
- School personnel will be accessible to students for help concerning courses, assignments, remedial assistance, personal and career decisions and other school matters.
- Teachers will present clear, relevant lessons along with explanations for the evaluation procedures to be used.
- Teachers will evaluate and return assignments within a reasonable time.
- They will have the opportunity to participate in a range of activities offered in the School Division.
- They will be treated appropriately with courtesy, respect, consistency and fairness.

TEACHERS AND STAFF CAN BE EXPECTED TO:

- Teach the Manitoba curriculum and to provide the services available from the Fort la Bosse School Division.
- Take personal responsibility for continuous professional development and growth.
- Communicate information regarding student progress, attendance, and behavior to students, parents and administration.
- Provide a positive role model.
- Provide an atmosphere that challenges each student to perform to the best of his/her ability and that fosters a love of learning.
- Treat each student appropriately with fairness, consistency, courtesy and respect.
- Establish a safe, non threatening learning environment.
- Respect and demonstrate consideration for other cultures and other peoples' differences.
- Evaluate student achievement and ensure that the evaluation procedures are understood by all.
- Be approachable and open to input from parents and students.

TEACHERS AND STAFF CAN EXPECT THAT:

- They will work in an environment that is safe, secure and non threatening.
- Students will attend classes regularly and punctually with necessary material and completed assignments and work to the best of their ability.
- Students will behave appropriately on the way to and from school.
- Parents will communicate openly with them about matters that might affect the school performance of the student.
- Students will have respect for and be courteous towards them.
- Everyone associated with the school will be treated with courtesy.
- Students will develop self-discipline and use common sense.

PARENTS CAN BE EXPECTED TO:

- Ensure that their son/daughter attends regularly and punctually and completes all school assignments.
- Be good, positive role models.
- Provide students with appropriate dress, nutrition, rest, and school supplies.
- Give positive input and support to the school and its programs and activities.
- Maintain open and regular communication with appropriate staff and with their son or daughter about school matters.
- Encourage their child's positive behavior to and from school.
- Encourage their son or daughter to:
 - *Work to the best of his/her ability
 - *Understand the importance of and to take an active role in their own education
 - *Respect the rights, property, and resources of fellow students, staff, and community
 - *Recognize the authority of school staff and to ensure a safe, secure, non threatening learning environment
 - *Demonstrate consideration for other cultures and other peoples' differences

PARENTS CAN EXPECT THAT:

- Teachers will diligently teach the required Manitoba Education and Training curriculum while providing accommodation for individual needs and learning styles.
- Teachers will conduct themselves in a professional manner and will provide a positive role model.
- All staff will cooperate to create a positive learning environment that is safe, caring, and challenging.
- Teachers will communicate to the home information about a student's progress, attendance, and behavior.
- Students will be treated appropriately with courtesy, respect, consistency and fairness.
- Student evaluation will be appropriate and procedures will be understood by all.
